
HORIZON EUROPE


- Horizon Europe is the EU's key funding programme for research and innovation with a budget of €95.5 billion
- It tackles climate change, helps to achieve the UN's Sustainable Development Goals and boosts the EU's competitiveness and growth
- Missions: Sets of measures to achieve bold, inspirational and measurable goals within a set timeframe. There are 5 main mission areas as part of Horizon Europe

ADAPTATION TO CLIMATE CHANGE

- The Mission on Adaptation to Climate Change focuses on supporting EU regions, cities and local authorities in their efforts to build resilience against the impacts of climate change
- The Mission's objective is to accompany by 2030 at least 150 European regions and communities towards climate resilience
- On 17 April 2024, the Commission adopted an amendment to increase the 2024 budget of the missions by nearly €1.4 billion to a total of €7.3 billion

- The Mission contributes to putting the EU's adaptation strategy in practice by helping the regions to:
 - better understand the climate risks they are and will be confronted with in the future
 - develop their pathways to be better prepared and cope with the changing climate
 - test and deploy on the ground innovative solutions needed to build resilience



- HORIZON-MISS-2024-CLIMA-01-08: Demonstration of approaches by regions and local authorities focused on increasing climate resilience of the most vulnerable social groups (just climate resilience) - EUR 22 500 000.02 - 3 project
- HORIZON-MISS-2024-CLIMA-01-09: Systemic and cross-sectoral solutions for climate resilience, tailored to the local needs of regions and local authorities EUR 27 000 000 3 project







RESTORE OUR OCEAN AND WATERS

- Aims to protect and restore the health of our ocean and waters through research and innovation, citizen engagement and blue investments
- The Mission's new approach will address the ocean and waters as one and play a key role in achieving climate neutrality and restoring nature
- The Mission supports regional engagement and cooperation through area-based "lighthouses" in major sea/river basins (Danube)

A SOIL DEAL FOR EUROPE

- The main goal of the Mission 'A Soil Deal for Europe' is to establish 100 living labs and lighthouses to lead the transition towards healthy soils by 2030
- It is estimated that between 60 and 70% of EU soils are unhealthy
- The Mission will support the EU's ambition to lead on global commitments, notably the Sustainable Developement Goals and contribute to the European Green Deal
- Targets on sustainable farming, climate resilience, biodiversity and zero-pollution. It is also a flagship initiative of the long term vision for rural areas

- Leads the transition towards healthy soils by funding an ambitious research and innovation programme with a strong social science component
- Putting in place an effective network of 100 living labs and lighthouses to co-create knowledge, test solutions and demonstrate their value in real-life conditions
- Developing a harmonised framework for soil monitoring in Europe
- Raising people's awareness on the vital importance of soils




