

143 Plenty happening at the caves

There's plenty going on this weekend at Aggtelek in northern Hungary, the country's most remarkable system of caves.

In the Baradla Cave, musicians attending the international youth camp at Nyírbátor perform under conductor Árpád Joó at 11 am on Friday. There are Tchaikovsky, Bach and Borodin works

on the programme. From Friday to Sunday artworks from the Mihály Zichy Gallery will be on show in the open air outside the cave entrance. They include paintings, posters and enamel works.

At 10 am on Saturday, two Hungarian and one French band play outside the cave. They are all attending an international Gypsy folk music gathering nearby.
